

ANNULAR SOLAR ECLIPSE










On Wednesday, October 2, 2024, there will be an annular solar eclipse during which the Moon will pass in front of the Sun without completely covering it. This occurs because the Moon follows an elliptical orbit around our planet, so it will be at a relatively greater distance, appearing consequently a bit smaller in the sky. Therefore, what would be a total eclipse under other circumstances, with the Moon closer, becomes an eclipse where a bright "ring" of the Sun remains around it. This is where the word "annular" comes from. Depending on the distance between the celestial bodies, on this occasion, the Moon will cover approximately 86% of the Sun.



Transfer from Comodoro Rivadavia airport to Estancia La Serena Trek to the Cañadón del Río Pinturas and the Cueva de las Manos

02/10

Trails of Parque Patagonia to enjoy the annular solar eclipse in the afternoon

Sailing to the Marble Chapels and Cathedrals Return transfer to the airport with a visit to the Lobería of Caleta Olivia on the way

DETAILED ITINERARY

30/09

Arrival at Comodoro Rivadavia airport on the first morning flight (AR1822), reception and transfer to Los Antiguos, with a visit to the Petrified Forest of Sarmiento en route, aiming to arrive at the destination around 7 PM. NOTE: We suggest flying the day before to rest better and have a greater safety margin in case of any delays. In that case, we will pick you up from the specified accommodation.

01/10

The deep Cañón del Río Pinturas houses the most important archaeological site in Patagonia. The Cueva de las Manos features cave paintings that record human presence in the area over nearly ten thousand years. The proposal is to emulate our ancestors and access the site via the same trail they used in antiquity, trekking through the canyon to finally visit the Archaeological Trail. On the return, we will trek to the striking Tierras de Colores, an ideal spot for photography with great scenic beauty and a source of raw material for the region's rock art.

02/10


A day entirely dedicated to exploring the trails of Parque Patagonia, culminating in the afternoon with the eclipse. The day begins with a visit to the Elsa Rosenvasser Feher Interpretation Center and Planetarium, where we will receive an introductory talk for observing the annular eclipse. Following this, the adventure continues with the spectacle of native wildlife across more than 50 kilometers of trails that traverse imposing cliffs, panoramic mountain views, vibrant colored lands, and deep canyons. The Cañadón Pinturas Portal safeguards the wildest nature of the Patagonian steppe. In the afternoon, we will position ourselves in a privileged location to enjoy the annular solar eclipse, which will start at 4 PM, reach its peak at 5:25 PM, and end at 6:43 PM. We will be equipped with special glasses for this

03/10

A day devoted to sailing to the Marble Chapels, discovering the vertiginous route, partly on a cliff, that crosses the mountain range, skirts the southern coast of the lake, and transitions from the steppe to the Patagonian Andean forest, culminating in an exclusive sail to the Marble Chapels.

04/10

Return to Comodoro Rivadavia airport with a visit to the sea lion colony at the Caleta Olivia RNP along the way, aiming to arrive at 3 PM for flights departing after 4 PM.
